

BLUEWATERS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT REGULAR BOARD MEETING APRIL 14, 2025

A. CALL TO ORDER

District Manager Armando Silva called the April 14, 2025, Regular Board Meeting of District to order at 6:19 p.m. at the Somerset Academy Silver Palms Cafeteria Room.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Mr. Silva presented proof of publication that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in the *Miami Herald* on September 30, 2024, as legally required.

C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

Mr. Silva determined that the attendance of Chairman Rodney Mejia and Supervisors Lorna Burnett and Lazaro Mederos constituted a quorum and it was in order to proceed with the meeting.

Staff in attendance included: District Manager Armando Silva and Associate District Manager Pablo Jerez of Special District Services, Inc.; and District Counsel Liza Smoker of Billing, Cochran, Lyles, Mauro & Ramsey, P.A.

Others in attendance: Patricia Figueroa, Miami, FL

D. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO THE AGENDA

There were no additions or deletions at this time.

E. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

There were no comments from the public for items not on the agenda.

F. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. November 11, 2024 - Regular Board Meeting Minutes

Mr. Silva presented the minutes of the November 11, 2024, Regular Board Meeting and asked if there were any corrections and/or revisions. There being no changes, a **motion** was made by Mr. Mejia, seconded by Mr. Mederos and passed unanimously approving the minutes of the November 11, 2024, Regular Board Meeting, *as presented*.

G. OLD BUSINESS

Mr. Medero requested an update on the installation of the traffic signal at SW 242nd Street and SW 112nd Avenue. Mr. Jerez advised that while the project had been approved, Miami-Dade County had not yet approved it for funding. Miami-Dade County chooses funding in late summer at which time we will follow up for an update.

Mr. Jerez advised that Miami-Dade County had updated their service request system and the previous service request numbers had been erased and the requests for repairing the sidewalk had to be resubmitted. The County provided the timeline of 6 months to 1 year before the repairs would be completed

H. NEW BUSINESS 1. Consider Resolution No. 2025-01 – Adopting a Fiscal Year 2025/2026 Proposed Budget

Mr. Silva presented Resolution No. 2025-01, entitled:

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE BLUEWATERS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT APPROVING A PROPOSED BUDGET AND NON-AD VALOREM ASSESSMENTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025/2026; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Silva read the title of the resolution into the record and reviewed the proposed budget. He advised that since the overall proposed assessments were not increasing in the fiscal year 2025/2026, letters to residents would not be required. Furthermore, Mr. Silva stated as part of Resolution No. 2025-01, the Board must set a date for the public hearing to adopt the 2025/2026 final fiscal year budget and assessments. A discussion ensued after which:

A **motion** was made by Mr. Mejia, seconded by Mr. Mederos and unanimously passed to approve and adopt Resolution No. 2025-01, *as presented*, setting the public hearing to adopt the fiscal year 2025/2026 final budget and assessments for June 23, 2025, at 6:15 p.m. in the Somerset Academy Silver Palms Cafeteria Room located at 23255 SW 115 Avenue, Miami, Florida 33032; and further authorizes publication/notice of the budget public hearing, as required by law.

2. Consider Resolution No. 2025-02 – Registered Agent Change

Mr. Silva presented Resolution No. 2025-02, entitled:

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE BLUEWATERS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT DESIGNATING MICHAEL J. PAWELCZYK AS THE DISTRICT'S REGISTERED AGENT AND DESIGNATING THE OFFICE OF BILLING, COCHRAN, LYLES, MAURO & RAMSEY, P.A. AS THE REGISTERED OFFICE

Mr. Silva explained that Florida Statutes requires that the District designate a registered office and registered agent for the purpose of accepting service of process, notice, or demand that is required by law to be served upon the District. He further explained that it is necessary to designate a new registered agent and update the business address of the registered office. A discussion ensued, after which:

A **motion** was made by Mr. Mejia, seconded by Ms. Burnett and unanimously passed designating Michael J. Pawelczyk as the Bluewaters Community Development District registered agent, and designating the registered office at Billing, Cochran, Lyles, Mauro & Ramsey, P.A., 515 East Las Olas Boulevard, Suite 600, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301.

I. ADMINISTRATIVE & OPERATIONAL MATTERS

1. Reminder: Form 1 - Statement of Financial Interests Due: 07/01/2025

Mr. Silva reminded the Board that their financial disclosures are due July 1, 2025, and ethics training must be completed by December 31, 2025. He will send the Board e-mails reminders about the submittals.

2. Add-On: Consider Appointment to Seat #4

Mr. Silva stated that there was a vacancy in Seat #4 and asked if there were any interested persons who would like to serve on the Board of Supervisors of the District. Patricia Figueroa, a qualified elector in the State of Florida, stated that she was interested in serving on the Board of Supervisors of the District. A discussion ensued after which:

A **motion** was made by Mr. Mejia, seconded by Mr. Mederos and unanimously passed appointing Mr. Cuenca to serve the unexpired 4-year term of office in Seat #4 and such term of office will expire in November 2028.

Mr. Silva, Notary Public in the State of Florida, administered the Oath of Office to Ms. Figueroa and went over her duties and responsibilities with emphasis on the Sunshine Law, Financial Disclosure, Public Records Law and the Code of Ethics for Public Officials.

3. Discussion Regarding Memorandum Regarding the Legal Requirements for Miami-Dade County CDDs Owning/Maintaining Stormwater Management Systems

District Counsel submitted a memorandum advising the District of the legal requirements of owning and maintaining stormwater management systems within Miami-Dade County. Certain permitting requirements are now necessary as well as Operation & Maintenance manuals that are now required to submitted to Miami-Dade County.

J. BOARD MEMBER & STAFF CLOSING COMMENTS

There were no further Board Member or Staff closing comments.

K. ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Board, a **motion** was made by Mr. Mejia, seconded by Mr. Mederos and unanimously passed adjourning the Regular Board Meeting at 6:50 p.m.
